Cordova's Dirty Harry stops tardies

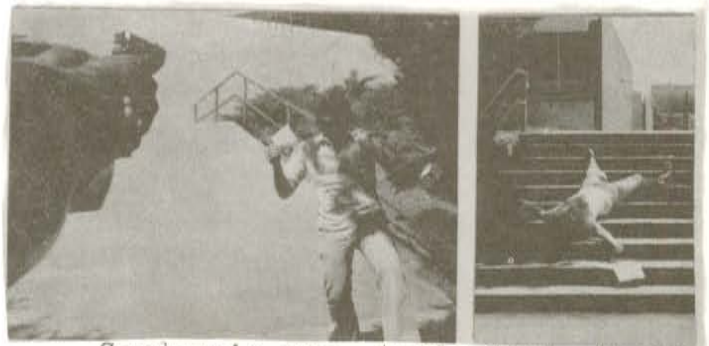
